## LANDWEHR FUNERAL

Hundreds of relatives and friends paid last tribute to Grandma Gertrude Landwehr, 104-year-old pioneer of Central Minnesota who died early Wednesday, when a requiem high mass was sung in the St. Mary's church at St. Augusta Friday morning with Rev. Charles Pingel, the pastor, officiating. After the requiem mass, the remains of the pioneer were viewed by many friends of the community in which Grandma Landwehr spent the greater part of her life. The interment was made in the adjacent parish cemetery beside Henry Landwehr, her husband. Six grandsons were pallbearers.
