Whitefish Man Killed In Automobile Crash

COLUMBIA FALLS — A Vietnam veteran who survived wounds in the Southeast Asia

conflict is dead today following a one car accident early this morning on Highway 40 west of the Blue Moon.

Henry Alex Landwehr, 25, Whitefish, who recently returned from Vietnam was killed instantly after he lost control of his car a quarter mile west of the Blue Moon at 5:50 a.m. today.

Investigating Montana highway patrolman said Landwehr's west-bound car traveled 864 feet after he lost control. It swerved back and fourth across the highway twice, left the left side of the roadway, hit a concrete abutment then sheared off a power pole.

Landwehr was thrown from the vehicle.

Officers said excessive speed was undoubtedly a factor in the accident. Impact of the crash tore the engine from the car. The car was demolished.

Funeral arrangements are pending at the Austin Funeral Home, Whitefish.
