

Landwehr Funeral Rites Set

WHITEFISH — Funeral services for Henry Alexander Landwehr, 25, Whitefish, who died early Thursday morning in an automobile accident on Highway 40 west of Columbia Falls, will be conducted Monday morning at St. Charles Catholic Church with the Rev. John Cronin as celebrant.

Rosary will be recited Sunday evening in the Austin Chapel and burial will be in the Whitefish Cemetery with military graveside rites.

Mr. Landwehr was a student at Wahpeton State School of Science at Wahpeton, N.D.

He was born Jan. 30, 1945, at Los Angeles, Calif., a son of Joseph and Lorine Landwehr. As a child he moved to Williston, N.D., with his parents, where he graduated from high school.

In 1965 he entered the U.S. Marine Corps and served in Vietnam where he received a number of decorations and commendations and was honorably discharged in 1967. Upon his honorable discharge he attended the University of Montana at Missoula until last year when he moved to Wahpeton. He was a Catholic.

He was preceded in death by his mother Dec. 30, 1968.

He is survived by his father, Joseph Landwehr, Whitefish; one brother, Ronald Landwehr, Columbia Falls; his maternal grandmother, Mrs. A. E. Hehmke of Pasco, Wash.; his paternal grandparents, Mrs. Lloyd Bond and J. B. Landwehr, both of Whitefish.
