

DOERNER RITES WELL ATTENDED

Burial of Pioneer Teacher Made Yesterday—Service at St. Mary Church.

One of the largest attended funerals in the history of St. Mary's parish was held Sunday afternoon at two o'clock for the late Edward Doerner, pioneer resident and school teacher here, who died at his home on Thursday evening.
