**Miss Frances Doerner and Guy
Peterson the Victims
of Accident**

A very sad accident occurred at Clear Lake last Saturday noon when Miss Frances Doerner of that town, and Mr. Guy Peterson of Clearwater, lost their lives by drowning.

It appears that the young people were out on the lake in a canoe and the seat occupied by Miss Doerner tripped over precipitating her into the water. Mr. Peterson very gallantly endeavored to save her from a certain death and in so doing lost his own life.

Miss Doerner was a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Edward Doerner of Clear Lake where Mr. Doerner is engaged in the general mercantile business, and Mr. Peterson was the son of Mr. and Mrs. David Peterson of Clearwater, and at the time of his death was manager of the lumber yard at Clear Lake. At the time of his death he was about in his twenty-fifth year and in the prime of life. The writer has known Mr. Peterson for the past fifteen years and we have no hesitancy in saying that he was in every way a most model young man. He was a nephew of Mr. and Mrs. W. F. Kothman of Maywood.
